VSL#3 (Probiotic Mixture) for Inflammatory Bowel Disease Trade Name: VSL #3

What is VSL#3?

VSL3 is a combination of eight different probiotics ("good bacteria") being used and tested for its effectiveness in treating Ulcerative Colitis and Inflammation of the small bowel-anal pouch after the large bowel has been removed for Ulcerative Colitis (this last condition is called "Pouchitis") One packet of VSL#3 contains 9×10^{11} (900 billion) bacteria consisting of:

Streptococcus salivarius subspecies thermophilus	~595 x 10 ⁹
Bifidobacterium (B. longum, B. infantis, B. brevis)	~270 x 10 ⁹
Lactobacillus acidophilus	~30 x 10 ⁹
Lactobacillus casei	~75 x 10 ⁹
Lactobacillus delbrueckii subspecies bulgaricus	~15 x 10 ⁹
Lactobacillus plantarum	~15 x 10 ⁹

What is the function of VSL#3 in the body?

Within your intestine there are many bacteria. Some of these bacteria are "bad" and some are "good". When you ingest enough of those good bacteria and if your health benefits from that these bacteria are called probiotics. Doctors believe that the probiotics help keep you and your intestine healthy and help prevent the bad bacteria from attacking your intestine.

Why do we think probiotics will work in inflammatory bowel disease?

There is some evidence to suggest that patients with inflammatory bowel disease have too many bad bacteria and not enough good bacteria in their intestine. In this regard, providing you with supplemental good bacteria could potentially help treat your inflammatory bowel disease. Some clinical trials are currently underway to test this hypothesis.

How is VSL#3 given?

VSL3 comes as a freeze-dried powder. It is mixed up in water or yogurt and taken once or twice daily.

What are the side effects of VSL#3?

Some patients complain of some bloating with VSL #3, which is mostly temporary. Therefore it is recommended to take these probiotics once daily in the first week or so.
